## Christmas cards in calligraphy

- 1. Practice your letters on rough paper first
- 2. Sketch your design onto your card in pencil
- 3. Write one letter at a time in ink.
- 4. Take a breath between each letter!
- Turn your card around to add a design around the edge (so you don't smudge what you've written)

## Calligraphy envelopes

- 1. Practice your design in pencil and paper
- Sketch your banner outline in pencil on the envelope
- 3. Sketch in the rest of your design
- 4. Rule faint pencil lines to write on
- 5. Write in your letters, slowly, in ink
- Add a few stars and sparkles, turning the envelope round as you go

## Wrapping paper

Writing the same words over and over is the BEST practice for calligraphy!

- I. Choose one or two phrases
  - · e.g. 'Festive Greetings' and 'Silent Night'
- 2. Rule faint pencil lines diagonally on your paper, from the top left corner
- 3. Write your first phrase in white ink
- 4. Add a holly / starburst / other illustration
- 5. Write your second phrase
- 6. Repeat until the paper is covered!
